Visitation Guidelines

Welcome to Friends Hospital. It is our goal to provide the highest quality of healthcare to our patients. In order to do so, we have established some guidelines. Many of these guidelines are in response to mental health laws and regulations and all of our guidelines seek to protect the safety, rights and confidentiality of our patients. Please review these guidelines before you visit. Any item not allowed on a unit, please leave it in your car.

The following are not allowed on any unit at any time: Audio or visual recording devices, cell phones, cameras, flowers or balloons, outside food or drink.

Visitor's Badges: You must check in with the receptionist in the Admissions Department lobby before you present to the units. The receptionist will provide you with a dated visitor's sticker when you sign in and we require that you wear this sticker in a prominent place at all times while on our grounds. If you present to the units without this sticker you will be asked to return to the receptionist.

Patient Belongings and Valuables: Please give all items to the staff when you enter the unit. All items will be searched and inventoried by staff members. We highly recommend refraining from bringing valuable items to the hospital. The hospital is not responsible for any items lost or stolen. Only two visitors at a time per patient are allowed on the unit.

Visiting in Patient Rooms: All visitors must remain in designated visiting areas on the unit - you are not allowed to visit in patients' rooms or behind closed doors.

Visit Termination: If at any time during your visit you become disruptive to the unit or if your presence is upsetting to the patient - you may be asked to leave. All patients have the right to refuse any visitor and have the option of terminating your visit at any time.
