

Adolescent Unit – BS2

Arrival time for visitation: 15 minutes prior to the start of visitation. Safety screening detailed below

- Wednesday: 1:00pm-2:00pm

The safety of everyone is our top priority. Please read the following information concerning our visitation process in its entirety. Any questions can be directed to the assigned social workers, or administrator on duty

- All visitors must be on the approved visitor list
 - Visitors are approved by Social Worker and **must be over the age of 18**
 - Visitors will be limited to parents, guardians, and immediate family
- Visitors must register for the day they wish to participate in visitation
 - Visitors will register with the assigned Social Worker for the day they wish to visit
 - Wednesday visitation - visitors must be registered prior to 12pm the day of visitation
 - Saturday visitation - visitors must be registered prior to 12pm the Friday before
 - Individuals admitted on Tuesday are eligible for visitation on Saturday. Individuals admitted on a Friday are eligible for visitation on the following Wednesday
- Arrival time is for day of visitation is **15 minutes prior** to the start of visitation
 - Anyone who arrives after the designated start time will not be permitted back for visitation
 - All visitors will be COVID screened upon arrival. Visitors may be denied entry to the facility depending upon screening results
 - Visitors will be wanded with a metal detector prior to entry into the facility.
 - Visitors will check in with Crisis Response Center (CRC) staff who will confirm registration. Visitors must present ID (Driver's license or valid state identification). If an individual is not on the registration list they will not be permitted to visit.
 - If the person visiting does not have proper identification that also matches the name on the registration, they will not be permitted to visit.
- No items are permitted to enter the visitation area. It is recommended leaving any personal items in your car prior to entering the building. If the visitor does not have a vehicle, lockers are also provided to secure belongings
 - This includes but is not limited to phones, keys, purses, coats, food, drinks, etc.
 - **The only item needed for visitation is your ID.** All visitors are required to show their ID upon arrival
 - If you wish to drop off items for the individual you are visiting, you may leave them with the front desk
- There is a limit 2 visitors per individual each visitation time
 - Once escorted back, visitors will remain in the designated area until visitation concludes
 - All visitors will be escorted back at the same time, visitors may not switch out part way through
